According to the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD), all new construction and existing buildings undergoing renovation have to meet Nearly Zero Energy Building (NZEB) standards by 2020. Technologies for energy efficient and sustainable construction exist but progress in its use differs between regions.

How far have we come in Sweden compared to other regions in Europe? Are we in the lead and what can we learn from other regions? The project «MountEE – sustainable building in mountain regions» supports municipalities in Sweden, Austria, France and Italy in order to become front runners in energy efficient and sustainable construction.
